Northern Kentucky University partners with 2trg to provide free electronic waste recycling

Northern Kentucky University (NKU), a public university in Highland Heights, Kentucky, is sponsoring an electronics recycling event with 2trg, an electronics recycler based in Cincinnati, Ohio, to accept unwanted household electronic waste (e-waste) from NKU staff, students, and residents in the Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky metropolitan area. Electronics can be dropped off for free during the event on Saturday, October 22, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m at NKU's Central Receiving dock on Nunn Drive.

Acceptable items include cables, CD-ROM drives, cellular telephones, circuit boards, computer speakers, CPUs, CRT monitors, docking stations, DVD players, fax machines, hard drives, keyboards, laptops, LCD monitors, mainframes, mice, modems, PDAs, personal copiers, printers, processor chips, scanners, servers, speakers, tape and disc drives, telephones, televisions, terminals, UPS battery backups, and VCR players. Ballasts, batteries, light bulbs, microwaves, and appliances will **not** be accepted. Cash donations of \$4 per monitor and \$10 per television are encouraged. All proceeds will support NKU Green.

A convenient drive-through drop-off station will be available to NKU staff and students as well as residents at the NKU's Central Receiving dock parking lot located on Nunn Drive across from Parking Lot I. Businesses may not participate in this event.
